7 Techniques:

- Even Wash
- Wet in Wet
- Dry Brush
- Stippling
- Salt
- Wax Resist
- Blotting

Key Points to Remember:

- Light pencil lines
- Watercolor is transparent (see through), not opaque (solid, bold unable to see through)
- Let the water help with forming different shades of colors (look carefully at the different colors you see in your picture)
- Let the paper dry between layers of paint
- Muddy water always creates muddy paintings
- Let the water depict edges
- Practice techniques on another piece of paper before applying on the actual painting.
